BILINGUAL TEACHER AIDE

Job Description:

Under the teacher's or principal's supervision, to assist in the instructional process, construct and/or organize materials for classroom environment and instruction; to correct student papers and assist in the supporting activities such as library, audio-visual, clerical and pupil testing; conference with teachers and parents.

Qualifications:

- 1. High School graduate or approved education for each position.
- 2. Proficiency in the use of English/Math as demonstrated by a qualifying test. Specific skills required by the position.
- 3. Personal characteristics compatible to the teaching process such as enthusiasm, flexibility, compassion, timeliness and accuracy.

Typical Duties:

1. Classroom Aide

- 1.1 Listen to children read, tell stories. Read to children.
- 1.2 Assist in math and writing assignments.
- 1.3 Continue instructional lessons on a large or small group basis as directed by the teacher.
- 1.4 Assist in the clerical; correction of papers, preparation of lesson.
- 1.5 Supervise the playground.

2. In the Bilingual Lab

- 2.1 Assist in the identification of pupils who may need bilingual assistance.
- 2.2 Administer proficiency tests.
- 2.3 Conference with classroom teachers concerning lessons and pupil home work.
- 2.4 Provide supplemental classroom activities for reading and language arts instruction.
- 2.5 Conference with parents concerning the pupil's progress and future exit from the program.
- 2.6 Develop an independent learning program for each child.
- 2.7 Set a goal to have each pupil exit the program as soon as possible.
- 2.8 Provide for follow up for one year after the pupil exits the program.
- 2.9 Serve as a translator for parent conferences.
