ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

- Create and maintain effective environments for student learning. Create a caring learning community where each student is treated fairly and respectfully. Reflect diversity and encourage productive interactions among students.
- 2. Address the needs of English learners, students with disabilities and low socioeconomic status to provide equitable access to the content.
- 3. Connect learning to students' prior knowledge, backgrounds, life experiences and interests. Connect subject matter to meaningful, real-life contexts.
- 4. Collect and analyze assessment data from a variety of sources to inform instruction. Monitor student learning and adjust instruction while teaching.
- 5. Develop and sequence instructional plans to support student learning which include both short and long-term projects.
- 6. Establish professional goals and engage in continuous and purposeful professional growth and development. Participate in teacher enrichment activities and staff development focused on agreed-upon areas of program development when school funds allow.
- 7. Hold parent/teacher conferences and communicate with parents through weekly notes, phone calls, email, etc.
- 8. Take part in the site and PLC/collaboration in order to help prepare students for the standards-based program.
- 9. Provide a positive classroom management system and learning environment.
- Promote self-directed, reflective learning for all students by engaging students in problem solving, critical thinking and other activities that make subject matter meaningful.
- 11. Establish and Articulate goals for student learning though the designing and implementing of both short and long-term classroom projects.
