  - a. Mrs. Coleman read the Before/ After School Program response by the Superintendent Robeson.

5. 2019 CAASPP Scores
  - a. Mrs. Coleman walked attendees through the CAASPP progress, and explained although we outperform the county and state, we are still focused on improving math learning.
    - i. Q: Do Principals meet about the scores like at Ripona and Weston? Mrs. Coleman responded that principals review scores, look for strengths and areas for improvement. They meet with teachers to plan next steps. Dr. Robeson and Mrs. Coleman meet with principals to discuss results and site plans.
  - b. Mrs. Coleman projected the new Science scores just updated on the Dashboard.
    - i. Coleman explains these are last year's scores and we expect growth with the new curriculum adopted by the district.

  - b. Coleman reviewed the 'score cards' and entered a school and reviewed the data under 'more details'.

    - i. Amie Walker asked about the areas that are 'grey' and why it is not projected.  
Mrs. Coleman explained the reason due to not having enough students that fit that demographic.
